For Ikki Films, production is above all a matter of storytelling, images, and people. Since our early days, we have been working with authors and coproducers from different horizons and conceive cinema as the reflection of the world. In 2019. we coproduced with Brazil and the Netherlands Sick, Sick, Sick. We are currently finishing two feature films, La Eterna Adolescente coproduced with Mexico, and Bodegón con Fantasmas coproduced with Spain; producing our first animated feature, Little Amélie, or The Character of Rain, a 100% French production; financing two documentaries coproduced with Argentina and Portugal; and developing an animated feature with Germany, Condenaditos. In 2023-2024 we released our latest short films: Box cutters, Nothing Special, A Small Number and Yuks!. In 2023, our short film Granny's Sexual Life received a César, after receiving a European Film Award.




